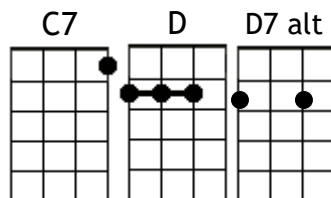
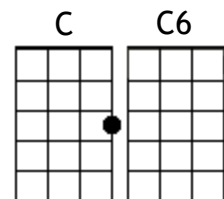
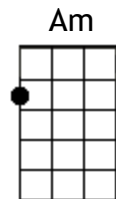
Strum: 1st verse, strum on chord change only.

 I'll tell you why I'm here and what my motives are.....

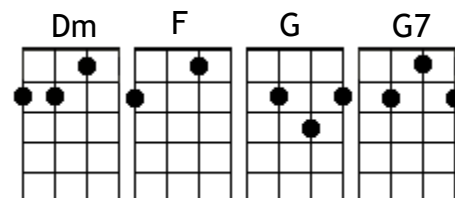
Strum: at single time....
