[D7] side [G7] by [C] side.

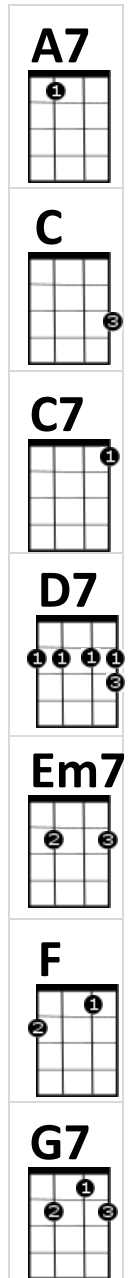
[C] Don't know what's comin' to[F]mor[C]row;
